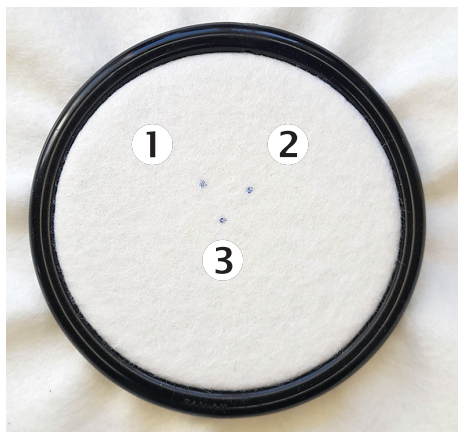


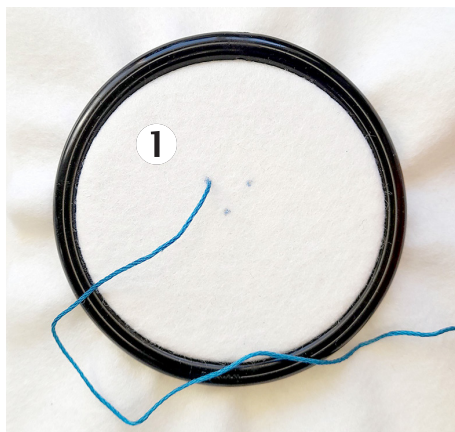
Detached Fly Stitch

Detached Fly Stitch is a simple yet effective embroidery stitch that creates V-shaped stitches that can add texture and detail to your projects. It's worked using three small points to form a neat loop that is gently anchored in place, giving the appearance of tiny feathers or petals. Once you've mastered the rhythm of the stitch, it becomes a relaxing and versatile technique that adds beautiful character to your sewing.

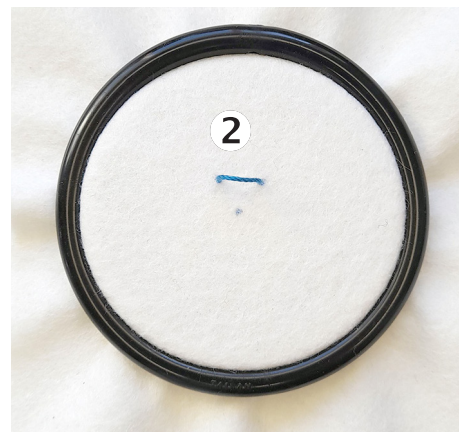
Step 1 - Draw three dots in a triangle.



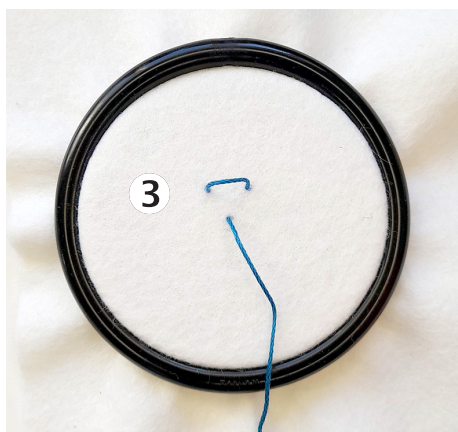
Step 2 - Bring the needle up from behind at dot ①.



Step 3 - Put needle back down at dot ②. Leave a loop.



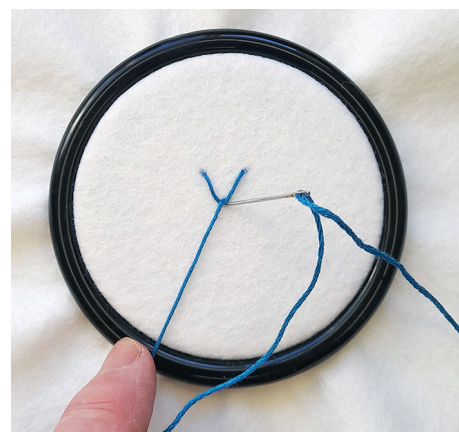
Step 4 - Bring the needle back up at dot ③, under the loop.



Step 5 - Pull down and keep the tension on the thread with your spare hand.



Step 6 - Pull down and keep tension on thread with spare hand.



Step 7 - Secure loop by inserting needle back into felt under loop thread at dot ③.
